2024 and 2025 are landmark years for East Neuk Festival: the 20th anniversary of the founding of the festival in 2004 followed by the 20th Festival in 2025. We aim to celebrate by looking back and looking forwards – but above all, by enjoying some of the very best live music the world has to offer in the wonderful East Neuk of Fife.

For ENF 2024, I am thrilled, once again, to offer you some exciting new discoveries alongside old friends. The schedule outlined here is not the full story – more will be added at our full launch in January.

Pianist, Hisako Kawamura is one of those musicians who seems never to get in the way of the music. To paraphrase George Orwell, good playing 'should be transparent, like a window pane', and when she plays you feel you are hearing the music straight from the heart of the composer. In recent years she has been championing music from her native Japan alongside European repertoire, and we will hear her play some of this alongside Beethoven and Schumann.

Two young ensembles also bring music from their homelands as they make their ENF debuts this year: from Norway/Sweden, Opus 13 string quartet bring Grieg, and from Prague, the Belfiato Wind Quintet offer Janáček, Haas and Reicha. Both play with all the freshness and vibrancy of youth tempered by a phenomenal musical maturity.

Old friends returning next year include clarinettist Julian Bliss (with and without his Septet), the Doric String Quartet, Catrin Finch, Renaud Garcia Fons, Boris Giltburg, Serkan Halili (Qanun), Mr McFall's Chamber, Pavel Haas Quartet, Kiko Ruiz (Flamenco Guitar) and Derya Turkan (Kemenche) and the Scottish Chamber Orchestra (SCO). I hope you will join us!
